

TELECOMMUNICATIONS NOTICE

REVISED PRICE CAP PLAN

1. The general public is hereby informed of a new Price Cap Plan (PCP) for regulating the fixed line telecommunications services of Cable & Wireless Dominica Limited trading as LIME (“LIME”), effective 15th April 2010.
2. In accordance with Regulation 28 (4) of the Telecommunications Retail Tariff Regulations, 2004, S.R.O. No. 18 of 2004, and the Eastern Caribbean Telecommunications Authority (ECTEL) and LIME having agreed on the provisions of the new PCP, the National Telecommunications Regulatory Commission (NTRC) has approved and adopted the revised PCP for LIME.
3. The main elements of the plan are as follows:-
 - (i) A complete removal and termination of all Access Deficit Charges (ADCs) on any and all services in all agreements of any kind.
 - (ii) A phased reduction in Fixed to Mobile (“FTM”) rates which will result in movement of FTM rates from 71¢ in some cases to an historic low of only 40¢ by 2011.

Effective Date	Price Reduction	FTM Maximum Price
April 15, 2010	1 st reduction from 71¢	57¢
October 1, 2010	2 nd reduction from 57¢	54¢
April 1, 2011	3 rd reduction from 54¢	49¢
October 1, 2011	4 th reduction from 49¢	40¢

- (iii) Extensive and transparent rules on bundling that will permit LIME to offer combinations of different services.
- (iv) New and extensive financial reporting requirements.
